How do we benefit and you SAVE?

WHEN IS TAX SEASON IN SOUTH AFRICA?

1 March 2022 - 28 February 2023 *Donate a few days before the 28th to allow for banking delays

WHAT IS A SECTION 18A CERTIFICATE?

Any taxpayer making a bona fide donation in cash or of property in kind to a section 18A-approved organisation, is entitled to a deducation from taxable income if the donation is supported by the necessary Section 18A receipt issued by the organisation (SARS.gov.za)

UP TO 10% REFUND

Receive up to 10% deduction on your annual tax payment to SARS. Section 18A of the Income Tax Act allows individuals to donate up to 10% of taxable earnings towards an approved Public Benefit Organisation on a tax-deductible basis.
